Mobile Phones in School

I am sure you have seen this in the news this week. To be clear, Ottershaw children have never been allowed to have a phone in school (unless needed for a medical emergency, such as to control or monitor blood sugar levels for our diabetic children). This also applies to other items with internet connectivity/photography access such as smart watches and fitness trackers.

I know some parents of older children would prefer their children to have a phone as they walk to school and back on their own but any phone must be handed in as children arrive in school. Similarly, staff do not use personal devices during teaching sessions either.
